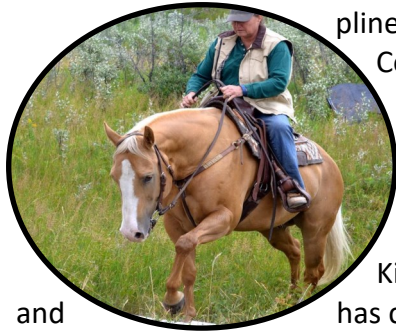

**Kim Repp Moats**

Kim has been involved with Cowboy Dressage since “the Beginning”, and was instrumental in bringing Cowboy Dressage to Canada. She was drawn to CD because it provides the opportunity for riders from all disciplines to progress with their horsemanship through the maneuvers and skills in the Cowboy Dressage Court while developing kindness and soft feel with their horses. She brings many years of all-round horsemanship experience to the CD court and is also studying biomechanics with the Science of Motion.



Kim is a Cowboy Dressage Level 3 clinician and has competed successfully winning multiple high points both at home and internationally. She is also a recommended Cowboy Dressage Judge and has judged in Canada, Australia and in the USA. She feels honored to have had the opportunity to judge several times at the Cowboy Dressage World Finals and Top Hand competitions.



**Lynn McEnespy**

I have been riding for a long time in various disciplines including Western Hunter/Jumper, 3 day Eventing and Dressage. At present, I ride and train three Warmbloods in regular and Cowboy Dressage. In “regular” Dressage I have competed in national shows at the FEI levels. My stallion, Waterford, was a national champion at 3rd level and highly placed at 4th level. In addition, I have qualified and ridden in several of our state and regional championship shows. I have focused on dressage for some time and currently am a USEF “R” licensed dressage judge and Dressage Sport Horse Breeding judge. I have been privileged to judge several Cowboy Dressage shows including every year at the Finals show in Rancho Murietta, CA and Arabian and Morgan shows. I currently judge “regular” dressage as well as Cowboy Dressage at several locations across the country.



My involvement with Cowboy Dressage began several years ago when it was just getting organized as a result of a friendship with Lyn Ringrose-Moe, one of the founders of the group. She requested that I judge Cowboy Dressage since I also have a bit of a background in western riding. I have been very impressed with the people and organization!
